On the Cover

Barren County is celebrating its 225th birthday, celebrating a rich and diverse history that spans over two centuries. Established in 1798, the county has evolved from a pristine wilderness to a thriving hub of business, agriculture, and industry. Let us embark on a journey through time, exploring the significant events, people, and milestones that have shaped Barren County into the vibrant community it is today.

Long before the arrival of European settlers, the land that would become

Barren County was home to various Native American tribes, including the Shawnee and Cherokee. However, as pioneers began to venture into the western frontier, the fertile soil and abundant resources of the region caught their attention.

One of the most prominent figures during this period was Joseph Horace Lewis, Lewis practiced law in Glasgow, was an elected member of the U.S. House of Representatives and the Kentucky House of Representatives, he was a volunteer for the Confederate Army ending his military career as a Brigadier General. Lewis spent his final year back home in Glasgow, KY practicing law and as a judge for the Kentucky Court of Appeals.

Throughout the 19th century, Barren County experienced significant growth in agriculture, which played a central role in its economy. The county's fertile land proved ideal for cultivating crops such as corn, tobacco, and wheat. Today, Barren County is a top agriculture producer of beef cattle and dairy in the state of Kentucky.

The city of Glasgow, named after the Scottish hometown of an early settler, became the county seat in 1803. Over the years, Glasgow flourished as a center of commerce and industry. The arrival of the railroad in the mid-19th century brought new opportunities for trade and transportation, solidifying the city's status as a regional hub.

As the 20th century dawned, education became a priority for Barren County's citizens. Schools were established throughout the county, and in 1908, the Glasgow Normal School was founded, later becoming Western Kentucky University's Glasgow campus.

The mid-20th century saw significant progress in infrastructure, healthcare, and industry. Modern amenities such as electricity, paved roads, and improved healthcare services transformed the county, making it an increasingly attractive place to live and do business. Dr. Carl Clifford Howard practice medicine in the area for nearly 60 years. He established the first hospital in Glasgow, brought in the first X-Ray equipment, he was instrumental in the creation of 6 tuberculosis hospitals in Kentucky and led the team that opened the T.J. Samson Hospital in 1929.

In recent decades, Barren County has continued to thrive, blending its rich history with modern developments. Agriculture remains a crucial part of the local economy, alongside a growing focus on manufacturing, healthcare, and tourism.

The region's natural beauty, including attractions like the Barren River Lake and Mammoth Cave National Park, draws visitors from far and wide. Festivals, cultural events, and historical sites keep the spirit of Barren County's heritage alive.

As Barren County celebrates its 225-year history, it stands as a testament to the resilience, determination, and ingenuity of its people. From the early pioneers who tamed the wilderness to the modern citizens shaping a vibrant community, each chapter in its story has contributed to the unique tapestry that is Barren County. As the County continues to evolve, it will undoubtedly embrace its past while striving for a bright and promising future.

Take a Closer Look at Barren County

Nestled between two major cities, Louisville, KY to the north and Nashville, TN to the south and central among major highways and interstates, Barren County is the perfect central location within the Southeast. Barren County offers easy access to rail services, two international airports, a highly skilled and available workforce, top ranking education systems including a four-year university and a technical college campus, all this located within a day's drive of most major markets.

The Barren County Economic Authority is the leading economic development organization for Barren County, with a primary mission to promote economic development through the retention and expansion of existing business and industry, attraction of new business and industry and support infrastructure development that meets the needs of business and industry.

With this mission in mind, the Authority has completed the development of Highland Glen Industrial Park. Product development continues at the South Cooper Industrial Park with the construction of two new speculative buildings. The Authority has started construction on a 100,000 sf speculative building on Lot 7 and a 50,000 sf facility, both slated to be completed in early 2024. In addition, work is nearing an end in Cave City's Chapatcha Park with the development of three pad ready sites directly off of I-65. Barren County is ready to serve new and growing industries that will benefit from all the community has to offer.

To encourage investment and job growth in the community, industries can receive local and state incentives. Resources such as the Kentucky Business Investment Program (KBI), a wage tax incentive, the Kentucky Enterprise Initiative Act (KEIA), that provides a sales tax abatement on building and construction materials, and access to the Kentucky Skills Network, which offers companies no-cost recruitment and job placement services, reduced-cost customized training and job training incentives. In Barren County, we are the one-stop shop to help coordinate all of your economic development needs, from site selection to incentives and talent recruitment, training and retention.



Southcentral Kentucky Community and Technical College makes the path to higher education easy by offering low tuition, numerous scholarships, caring faculty and staff, and flexible classes. From individuals who want to upskill in their current job, to high school students following their dreams, SKYCTC offers unmatched quality, affordability, and flexibility.

Flexible College Classes

With SKYFlex, students complete most of their classwork in online interactive modules. Then, the student goes to campus one day a week (per class) for a hands-on lab with the instructor. SKYFlex is perfect for students who plan to work while they attend college.

Unmatched Affordability

SKYCTC has the lowest college tuition in the state and is committed to helping students graduate without student loan debt. As a result, almost two-thirds of SKYCTC graduates completed their associate degrees without loans. Here are some of the scholarships that help students graduate free of student debt.



The DC to Finish Scholarship is the top tier of the SKYCTC merit scholarships offered to first-time college students. It provides \$5,000 per academic year to students who complete nine or more SKYCTC dual credit hours with a SKYCTC GPA of 3.0 or better. Since annual tuition is only \$4,368, students can easily graduate without debt!

The SKY Merit Scholarship is for first-time college students with high school GPAs ranging from 4.0 to 2.5. The annual award amount ranges from \$1,000 to \$4,000 based on the student's high school GPA.

The Work Ready Kentucky Scholarship (WRKS) can pay a student's total tuition cost. WRKS is not based on a student's income or age and allows students to earn up to 60 credit hours in high-demand career fields. Nearly all programs offered at SKYCTC qualify for the WRKS.

District Overview

Barren County School District is known for its innovative, caring culture. Comprised of seven elementary schools, one middle school, one high school, a freshman academy, and one alternative learning center, the district currently serves approximately 5,300 students in preschool through 12th grade. We are also home to the Barren County Innovation Zone and BAVEL, a virtual school for grades K-12. Additionally, Barren County Area

WKU in Glasgow Celebrates Enrollment Growth and Campus Enhancements

Western Kentucky University's fall semester is in full swing, and WKU in Glasgow is celebrating a year of growth and change. Student enrollment is up, and the campus has several additions that will improve service for students and the community.

First-Time Freshmen Enrollment

When WKU completes fall 2023 census details, WKU in Glasgow will report a significant increase in first-time freshmen enrollment numbers – up from 735 students in Fall 2022. This exciting growth is the result of targeted recruitment, increased course offerings, and a focus on preparing students for the most high-demand careers in this region.





Local Utilities



Farmers RECC

Farmers RECC is a not-for-profit electric cooperative, serving more than 26,000 services across eleven Kentucky counties, with a mission to provide reliable, competitively-priced energy that will enhance the quality of life for our member-owners and communities.

In Barren County, Farmers RECC, in conjunction with their power supplier, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, operates the Glasgow Landfill-Gas-To-Energy (LFGTE) plant. The plant harvests methane from the Glasgow Landfill and turns it into electricity, powering approximately 500 homes in the area.

The project was designed to be easily expanded as the landfill grows and more methane gas is produced.

In addition, the LFGTE project is providing a backup source of power to the Glasgow Water Company's waste water treatment plant, saving them from having to make a considerable investment to provide their own backup power source.

Farmers RECC was also able to assist the T.J. Community Mission Foundation by securing a \$2 Million zero-interest loan through the USDA Rural Economic Development Loan (REDLG) program. The loan aided in construction of the T. J. Community Mission Foundation Shanti Niketan Hospice Home.

The 10,400 square foot facility, located on Glenview Drive, opened in 2021 and included 8 inpatient rooms, kitchen and living spaces, and private areas for families and guests.

The loan funds were disbursed to the T. J. Community Mission Foundation and will be re-paid over time through donations to the Foundation and normal operations of the Hospice Home.

SCRTC

Serving the area for over seventy years, South Central Rural Telecommunications Cooperative (SCRTC) is well known in this region. With service in eleven counties, their reach is widespread. SCRTC started with telephone service in 1950 allowing rural customers to enjoy the latest technology for that time. SCRTC started providing internet services in 1995 and is still a leader in this evolving technology. The television services that began in 2002 are still provided along with streaming options.

While SCRTC is well known for their phone, tv and internet capabilities, the more recent offerings of Hosted PBX, SIP Trunking and Point to Point Wi-Fi services are a growing industry inside the cooperative.

Both large organizations and small businesses with many different phone lines are looking for an easier and more affordable way to manage their phone system. By using a Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) Hosted PBX System, this may be accomplished. Hosted PBX communicates internally with the company and externally with the outside. It allows more phones than actual phone lines with many options and features. For those wanting to manage their own system while still connecting to a trusted provider, SIP Trunking is also an option. This uses VoIP over a broadband connection to an on-premise PBX IP Interface. SIP Trunks rely on broadband connection rather than traditional telephone lines. SCRTC has been able to serve a variety of local schools, banks and businesses having multiple communication requirements using these options.

Point to point wi-fi is another SCRTC service growing recently. This service increases the range of Wi-Fi capabilities. A farmer may need internet for barns, residential customers may need wi-fi in a garage or at a pool, a business often needs expanded internet capabilities to remote parts of their location or off premise buildings. There are a variety of scenarios with customizable quotes.

Bounty of the Barrens: Growing Sustainable Roots

One of the marks of a sustainable community is a thriving farmers' market. Every Saturday from April to October, Glasgow's square comes alive with vendors selling seasonal fruits and vegetables, meats, eggs, honey, baked goods, herbs, local milk and dairy products, local wine, and other handcrafted items.

Many years prior to today's supply chain issues and food shortages, Sustainable Glasgow was formed to ensure current residents and future generations had access to all that this -rich community offers. One of the most visible projects brought to fruition, and still under management of this group of community leaders, is the local Farmer's Market called Bounty of the Barrens. For 16 years, local producers from Barren and surrounding counties have had a venue to sell products direct to the consumer.

Bounty of the Barrens is a local, producer-only Farmer's Market with over 25 local farmers and producers dedicated to providing the community with healthy, local food and products. To ensure that citizens' food needs are met, vendors accept SNAP, WIC, and Senior Farmers' Market Vouchers. Bounty of the Barrens also participates in a program called Kentucky Double Dollars, which provides additional financial incentives to low income and senior citizens. A partnership


with T.J. Regional Health made the Fresh Rx program available to eliminate food insecurities during pregnancy by providing families with weekly shares of food from local farmers to produce healthier pregnancies and better birth outcomes.

The opportunity for residents to purchase locally produced goods provides healthier food choices, reduces the carbon footprint, and promotes the education of both. It also allows the community a way to support local farmers and the local economy. This is especially important as Barren County leads all other Kentucky counties in active pastureland and ranks eighth in cropland. In 2022, Barren County was ranked the number one county in the state in beef production, dairy farms, cattle/calves, and second in the Central Region in wheat production and third in corn production (USDA).

Local musicians often come to perform during the market. The outdoor market opens each year in April with a 5K Race hosted by Sustainable Glasgow. In the winter months, Bounty of the Barrens resides at the Barren County Extension Office from November through March. Plans are underway to locate a permanent location for the Bounty of the Barrens that would further the roots of sustainability for the local agricultural economy and for local citizens, today and for future generations.




