JUDGING & AWARDS

All entries will be judged if you choose to. Entries will be judged in each of the seven categories listed on the entry application.

The criteria for judging these entries are as follows:

First impression and creativity 0-25 points
Reflection of Parade Theme 0-25 points
Lighting 0-25 points
General overall appearance 0-25 points

Total points possible 0-100 points

Winners in each category shall receive the following:

- First Place-Banner & Ribbon to Display on Float
- Runner Up-Banner

In addition, a "GRAND MARSHAL AWARD" winner will be selected from the first place winners in each of the seven categories. The winner of the "GRAND MARSHAL AWARD" will receive a trophy.



RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. CANDY WILL be allowed to be tossed into the crowd! Please use discretion when you are tossing the candy in the crowd!
- 2. ONLY the 1st 150 UNITS WILL BE ADMITTED INTO THE PARADE YOU MUST SPECIFY IF YOU ARE BRINGING A TRUCK AND TRAILER! WE HAVE TO KNOW THE LENGTH OF THE TRAILER. If you say truck and come with truck and trailer you will be turned away.
- 3. The headlights of all units shall be turned OFF during the parade. If the lighting for your unit is wired into the headlight circuit or if your headlights cannot be turned off, the headlights of the unit must be covered.
- 4. All units using portable generators shall have a working fire extinguisher and an ample supply of fuel aboard before entering the staging area. No fueling shall be allowed along the parade route.
- 5. No smoking shall be allowed in or on any unit from the time the unit arrives at the staging area until it reaches the end of the parade route.
- 6. Horn blowing shall be reserved for members of the bands in the parade. Please, no horn or sirens!
- 7. All units MUST be decorated for Christmas except for dignitary units, military units, bands, which shall be exempt from this rule.
- 8. Each entry MUST be decorated and MUST have Christmas lighting. If your entry does not have lighting, you will not be allowed to participate in the parade.
- 9. All music or singing must be songs of the theme or Christmas season.
- 10. No livestock on foot are allowed in parade.
- 11. No motorcycles, go-carts, dirt bikes, mini bikes, ATV's, golf carts, or lawnmowers are allowed in the parade. You may display these vehicles on floats, but they may not be driven in the parade.
- 12. Only ONE unit per application per entry fee. Additional units that arrive the day of the parade will be turned away.
- 13. NO LIVE SANTAS ON ANY FLOAT except the Chamber of Commerce Santa float.

**If any of the above rules are broken, you may not be allowed to participate in future parades. **
